Q Signal	Used As a Question	Used As a Statement
<b>QRG</b>	What is my (his) frequency?	Your (His) frequency is -----
<b>QRH</b>	Does my frequency vary?	Your frequency varies
<b>QRI</b>	How is the tone of my transmission?	Your tone is 1 (good) 2 (variable) 3 (bad)
<b>QRJ</b>	Are you receiving me badly? Are my signals weak?	I cannot receive you. I receive you badly
<b>QRK</b>	What is the readability of my (his) signals?	Your (His) readability is (1)unreadable to (5)perfect
<b>QRL</b>	Is this frequency busy?	This frequency is in use
<b>QRM</b>	Are you being interfered with?	I am interfered with
<b>QRN</b>	Are you troubled by static?	I am being troubled with static
<b>QRO</b>	Must I increase power?	I increase power
<b>QRP</b>	Can I decrease power?	I decrease power
<b>QRQ</b>	Shall I send faster?	Send faster ----- WPM
<b>QRS</b>	Shall I send slower?	Send slower ----- WPM
<b>QRT</b>	Shall I stop sending?	Stop sending
<b>QRU</b>	Have you anything for me?	I have nothing for you
<b>QRV</b>	Are you ready?	I am ready
<b>QRX</b>	When will you call me again?	I will call you again at -----
<b>QRZ</b>	Who is calling me?	You are being called by ----
<b>QSA</b>	What is the strength of my (his) signals?	Your (His) strength is (1)barely perceptible - (5)very good
<b>QSB</b>	Are my signals fading?	Your signals are fading
<b>QSL</b>	Can you acknowledge receipt?	I acknowledge receipt
<b>QSO</b>	Can you communicate with -----?	I can communicate with -----
<b>QSP</b>	Will you relay to -----?	I will relay to -----
<b>QST</b>		Calling all radio amateurs
<b>QSV</b>	Shall I send a series of V's?	Send a series of V's
<b>QSX</b>	Will you listen to ----- on ----- kHz?	I am listening to ----- on -----
<b>QSY</b>	Shall I change frequency?	Change frequency to -----
<b>QSZ</b>	Shall I send each word twice?	Send each word twice
