I took off on an overcast day in my 4x4 Jimny for Whariti peak, loaded up with a 12v 5amp battery along with a 430, G5RV plus lots of other stuff too much to mention.

I received very well getting 11QSO's on 80m. My transmission was as expected not that flash only just being picked up by 3 or 4 people. The weather was just too windy and cold so I headed for home, after feeling yes, I did okay, and with a new 25amp battery I will do the P.O.T.A. thing for sure.

One thing I did find out was that you can only use Simplex on 2metres. I only have one regret -- I should have done this "Hamster" thing 40 years ago.
