

From the Presidents Desk

As I sit here at the kitchen table penning this article prior to heading out to activate ZL1/MW-137 as part of the ZL3CC Memorial Day I reflect back over one of the most challenging years of my life at least. I have seen through the Covid-19 restrictions resurgence in Amateur radio activity in our area – and no doubt other areas of the country. Amateur Radio is vastly different from when I was first involved back in the mid-1970's at school, the breadth of activities and technology means there is something for everyone. I am mindful of the need as ambassadors of the Amateurs Radio, of the need to embrace the future while maintaining and treasuring the technologies and folks who have gone before us – both are equally as important.

Our next club meeting will be either via Zoom or in person at the club rooms depending on the Covid-19 restrictions in place at the time. need to take on board as digital technology develops worldwide and to see where we as a club fit in with that.


